Apply to the American Board of Medical Specialties Visiting Scholars Program

The <u>ABMS Visiting Scholars Program</u>[™] is an annual grant program that supports early-career physicians and researchers in their research and facilitates their evolution as health care leaders within and across the ABMS community.

Grants of \$15,000 are awarded to support research and travel expenses associated with program participation and research deliverables. The grant may be applied to an existing research project with a new scope or an original research project.

The 2025-2026 program begins September 2025 and concludes at ABMS Conference 2026.



The American Board of Ophthalmology is a co-sponsor of the ABMS Visiting Scholars Program. The board is interested in research that:

- Evaluates the effectiveness of its programs and activities;
- Examines the relationships between certification and physician education, clinical practice, and career-long improvement;
- Contributes meaningfully to the literature about physician competence; and,
- Promotes psychometric equity, excellence, and fairness

THE ABMS VISITING SCHOLARS EXPERIENCE

Scholars advance their **research projects** and learn from:

- Certification, research, and data science subject matter experts
- National thought leaders in medical education, certification, and health policy
- Colleagues within and across the certification community
- Peers, research mentors, and scholar alumni

The ABMS Visiting Scholars Program is a year-long program beginning each year in September. During their program year, ABMS Visiting Scholars remain at their home institutions and work with self-selected mentors. Scholars provide research project updates during monthly webinar sessions. They get feedback and guidance from their peers, mentors, subject matter experts, and ABMS Visiting Scholars alumni.

Scholars attend virtual ABMS committee meetings and present their research findings before a national audience at the annual ABMS Conference.

ELIGIBILITY

The ABMS Visiting Scholars Program is ideal for individuals looking to positively impact their profession as well as specialty certification through research. Early career physicians, junior faculty, fellows, and residents are eligible, as well as individuals holding master or doctorate degrees in public health, health services research, educational evaluation and statistics, public health policy and administration, and Veterans Affairs trainees and researchers. Student visas are not available.

Proposed research projects can be established projects with a new scope of work or original projects. A research mentor must be identified through the application process. All applicants should consider the impact of their project on reducing health disparities and contributing to the development of a qualified and diversified workforce.
